

CHANGING THE LIGHT BULB IN THE SHOWER

I guess you thought that the E-mailer only knows how to email. Wrong! A resident asked if I knew how to change the light bulb in the shower and even though I haven't changed that bulb in 6 years, I gave him the answer. The answer wasn't to put Greta on the ladder and once she holds on to the bulb, just turn the ladder counterclockwise to remove the bulb and then clockwise to put the new bulb in.

This fixture requires you to pull down on the rim, so here is the response from the resident:

Pulling down hard from both sides of the plate did the trick. I guess the moisture must cause it to stick to the recessed can. Also, once it is down you must unscrew a set screw then turn the white baffle to the left to remove it. The bulb is a 50 watt halogen sealed flood lamp
